

MiddlesexMap Colours Your World!

The 2006 Aerial photo on MiddlesexMap can now be viewed in colour. Zoom in to your area of interest, choosing a map width of LESS THAN 1 km. Then, turn on the Aerial Photography layer by checking the box beside 'Aerial Photos' in the menu and clicking the 'Redraw Map' button.

NOTE: The aerial photography image automatically changes to black and white at map widths of 1km or greater.



Also new on MiddlesexMap is the option to view aerial photography from an earlier year. Choose 1999-2003 from the drop-down menu under 'Aerial Photos' and click 'Redraw Map'.

About the 1999-2003 Aerial Photo

This photo is made up of three separate aerial photographs obtained from three Conservation Authorities having jurisdiction within the County (Ausable Bayfield, Upper Thames, St. Clair Region C.A.s). The photo for the Ausable Bayfield Region, Upper Thames Region and St. Clair Region were taken in 1999, 2001 and 2003 respectively.
